

**THINGS TO BRING WHEN YOU APPLY FOR A
MARRIAGE LICENSE:**

- 1) A **valid drivers license** or other form of acceptable photo identification
- 2) **Proof of residency**- physical address on your drivers license or a utility bill
- 3) **A witness**, 18 years of age or older **with proper identification**
- 4) **\$28 Application fee** (cash, check or money order made out to the Borough of Beach Haven)
- 5) Proof of dissolution of a previous marriage, civil union or domestic partnership (divorce decree, death certificate or dissolution paperwork)

* Social Security number is required by law for U.S. citizens and will be kept confidential.

There is a waiting period of 72 hours after applying for a marriage license

If you are a New Jersey Resident looking to get married in New Jersey, you must apply for a marriage license in the municipality where either partner lives. Marriage licenses issued in New Jersey to New Jersey residents can be used in ANY New Jersey municipality.

If you are a New Jersey Resident looking to get married outside of the state, you must apply for your marriage license in either the state or country you are planning to get married in.

If you are an Out-of State-Resident, who wishes to get married in New Jersey, you must apply for a marriage license in the municipality where the ceremony is to take place.

Pavilion information

Any couple interested in having their ceremony at one of Beach Haven's Pavilions located on the Beach- Pearl Street and 5th Street and the Bay Front- Taylor Avenue.

BE AWARE:

- 1) There are **no reservations** for the use of a Pavilion, they are first come first serve
- 2) Our pavilions are open to the public; you **can not** keep the general public from using them
- 3) We ask that if you have decorations, that they be free standing or can be tied; **Please do not nail, tack or staple anything into the pavilion structure.**
- 4) Please clean-up after yourself
- 5) Since the pavilions are public property, there is **no consumption of alcoholic beverages allowed.**
- 6) The pavilions are not equipped with electrical outlets, if a sound system is need it must be self contained.
